

Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union  
Board of Directors Meeting  
July 22, 2011 Summary

- Representative Council Appointments
  - Scott Dryer who was a Representative Council member for the past two years has accepted a new job outside of the Northeast District. Keith Turner, High School Principal of Rudd-Rockford-Marble Rock as been appointed to serve the final year of the term.
- Golf Advisory Committee
  - The Board of Directors were asked by the Golf Advisory Committee to consider requiring each state qualifying team to bring a scorekeeper for both days to the State Golf Tournament. The GAC approved this recommendation unanimously. [The Board of Directors passed the request unanimously.](#)
  - The Board of Directors were asked by the GAC to consider to expand the individual medalist awards from the top eight individuals to the top ten individuals at the State Golf Tournament. The GAC approved this recommendation unanimously. After looking through what the Union did for like sports [the Board of Directors passed this request unanimously.](#)
- Track and Field Advisory Committee
  - The Board of Directors were asked by the Track and Field Advisory Committee to not allow simultaneous field events during the District Track meet (Example would be those facilities that can have the boys and girls long jumping at the same time, but in different directions). The TFAC passed this unanimously. [The Board of Directors passed this request unanimously.](#)
  - The Board of Directors were asked by the Track and Field Advisory Committee to go back to the qualifying system for the State Track Meet utilized by the IGHSAU prior to the 2010-2011 school year. Class 4A would qualify the top two place winners and the next 12 best performances from all state qualifying meet place winners. Class 3A and 2A would qualify the top two place winners and the next best 8 best performances from all state qualifying meet place winners. Class 1A would qualifying the first place winner and the next best 12 performances from

all state qualifying meet place winner. The TFAC passed this 7-2. The Board of Directors passed this request unanimously.

- Basketball Mercy Rule
  - o The Board of Directors were asked to consider whether or not a Mercy Rule should be implemented in basketball for the 2011-2012 basketball season. The Mercy Rule that was presented was identical to the IHSAA Mercy Rule used this past season. Discussion took place and the implementation of a Mercy Rule died for the lack of a motion.
